Ride HARD for Paris.

In addition, we will provide periodic spiritual advice and/or someone to yell expletives and tell you that "it's hot." Riders who desire may tow a trailer -- preferably containing a small Chihuahua (towing a small dog means you can donate even less because of the homage).

We aim to hold Ride HARD for Paris on June 23 at approximately the half-way point of Paris' incarceration. This will be a celebration of her getting "over the hump." Watch this space for further details.
